<p><b>CLUB NAME AND IDENTIFICATION</b></p> <p>Our club is named Honryu Martial Arts but may also be referred to as Bujinkan Honryu Dōjō or BHD. The lead instructor is Bill Liddle.</p>
<p><b>PROFIT STATEMENT</b></p> <p>Our club is run as a commercial entity and whilst our income may only be limited, we may use any profits for the further provisions of club equipment, training and drawings for staff.</p>
<p><b>LEGAL REGISTRATION</b></p> <p>Our club is registered as a Limited Company.</p>
<p><b>HONRYU MARTIAL ARTS STUDENT AUDIENCE</b></p> <p>Honryu Martial Arts provides classes to adults, young persons aged between 7 and 17.</p>
<p><b>COMPLAINTS AND DISPUTES</b></p> <p>Honryu Martial Arts has a complaints procedure in place and will always strive to provide the best service to its students and associated community members. <p><b>INSURANCE PROVISIONS</b></p> <p><b>INSTRUCTOR INSURANCE</b></p> <p>Honryu Martial Arts always ensures that all instructors are fully insured. Our instructor uses specialist instructor insurance provided by Towergate Insurance. A copy of any relevant insurance documentation is available on request.</p> <p><b>STUDENT INSURANCE</b></p> <p>Honryu Martial Arts always takes our responsibility to safeguard members seriously. Accordingly, we always insure our students through the British Martial Arts &amp; Boxing Association for member to member liability. Cover will only exist where a student is in receipt of an insurance or membership certification from British Martial Arts &amp; Boxing Association or, the case of students of Royal Holloway University, through Open Allocation where the RHUL Society Committee will be informed of the student's Open Allocation insurance number.</p>
<p><b>DBS CHECK STATUS</b></p> <p>Honryu Martial Arts teaches adults and children and so all instructors hold an enhanced disclosure which has been deemed to be acceptable. Evidence of this check may be provided on request or is available from <a href="https://www.bmaba.org/verify">BMABA.org/verify</a>.</p>



## **INSTRUCTOR GRADE REQUIREMENTS**

Honryu Martial Arts always ensures that our instructors are qualified to or above the minimum standard expected by our association. This is at least BMABA Level 1 Coaching Qualification and black belt certification.

## **FIRST AID STATUS**

Honryu Martial Arts takes the safety of its members seriously. All instructors are first aid trained to an acceptable standard and sufficient emergency first aid equipment is present at all classes or on site at all times. A risk assessment and associated health and safety briefs are conducted prior to classes commencing.

## **PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP**

Honryu Martial Arts takes its responsibilities to run a professional class seriously. Accordingly, we are registered with British Martial Arts & Boxing Association. Our membership number is 12361 and this may be verified at any point by visiting [bmaba.org/verify](http://bmaba.org/verify). Any associated membership certification is available on request or is viewable from [bmaba.org/verify](http://bmaba.org/verify).

We are also registered members of CIMSPA (Chartered Institute for Management of Sports and Physical Activity). Membership number is C002371.

## **FEES & CHARGES**

Honryu Martial Arts do not have any hidden costs or dishonest fee collections in place. All money is payable by direct debit through GoCardless or online through Stripe when due, and receipts will be issued on request.

Our club charges £25.00 registration fee to include association membership and insurance and this is payable 4 weeks after your first training session with us. This fee is payable yearly.

Classes are charged monthly by direct debit for ease of management. Monthly costs are £46 for adults and £40 for junior classes. Discounts are available for members of the NHS.

You are NOT bound by any contract and may discontinue training at any time.

## **INDEPEDENCE STATUS**

Honryu Martial Arts are associated with a professional association to ensure our standards are some of the highest available, however we remain legally independent and are not submitted to any compulsory regulation or obligation under any of the above named associations.

Accordingly, it is our club's responsibility to comply with local and national laws / regulations, and there is no recourse to our representing organisation in the event of any breach of law, regulation or protocol. We retain the right to be an independent club and govern ourselves by best practice whether we are inside or outside the membership / affiliation of any above named governing bodies.
